

Scholarship Form Attached

Since 2010 Arts in Strongsville has awarded three annual scholarships to selected high school seniors.

To be eligible for a scholarship, a student must be a resident of Strongsville or a student at Strongsville High School who plans to be a full-time student at a college or another institute of higher learning during the next academic year.

Members of the Arts in Strongsville Board of Trustees will select recipients from among the applications that are received on or before March 29, 2019. Scholarship recipients will be notified of their award by the Strongsville High School Guidance Department or by mail. A letter of intent will be given during the Senior Salute night at the high school or at an Arts in Strongsville board meeting. Scholarship checks will be issued to the recipient's financial account at the student's educational institution upon successful completion of the recipient's first term of college.

Candidates must submit their scholarship application and most recent grade transcript to the address below no later than Friday March 29, 2019. Any questions may be addressed to Amy McEntee, Amy@recycle.cc.


